The FY 2023-24 (AAP) is an all-encompassing document that provides a basis and strategy for the annual use for all federal funds granted to the Urban County of Orange by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs. The FY 2023-24 AAP also addresses related local funding received by Housing & Community Development (i.e. 15U Housing Funds). The FY 2023-24 AAP indicates preliminary awards based on HUD allocations for FY 2023-24. These appropriations support public facilities and improvements, public services, housing rehabilitation, and affordable housing development activities that benefit low-and moderate-income households.

The Substantial Amendment to the FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 Annual Action Plans is required to allow the City of Placentia to utilize unspent prior Community Development Block Grant funding for their Façade HR project. The Substantial Amendment 3 to the FY 2021-22 Annual Action Plan is a Scope Change for the City of Brea CDBG-CV reallocated funds.

**INVITATION TO BE HEARD:** Notice is hereby further given to provide the public a 30-day review period for the FY 2023-24 Annual Action Plan and Substantial Amendment to the FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 Annual Action Plans **beginning April 5<sup>th</sup>**, **2023**, **through May 8<sup>th</sup>**, **2023** to submit any concerns and/or comments. All persons either favoring or opposing the Annual Action Plan or Substantial Amendments are invited to present their views in writing or before the Board of Supervisors.
